Building CLIPSSA

The three methodological pillars of CLIPSSA

-  Scientifically robust interdisciplinary work that may include, if necessary and in consultation with the public authorities partners, recourse to specialist expertise.
-  Particular attention to the issue of data collection. Data is often difficult to obtain, which means that a dedicated methodology must be established based on prior targeting.
-  Solid partners and strong collective dynamics, particularly between researchers and institutional partners. The quality of these relationships is a methodological pillar in its own.

The workshops and consultation meetings began as soon as the project was launched in 2022 and lasted for over two years. They had two main objectives:

-  Encourage meetings and exchanges between stakeholders from different regions and the CLIPSSA project teams.
-  Collectively identify the issues, the subjects to be targeted to make a valuable contribution to local adaptation policies, and the study sites to be prioritised.

Organisation of the consultation

Between 2021 and 2023

-  Workshops and local meetings dedicated to each territory (French Polynesia, Vanuatu, Wallis-and-Futuna, New Caledonia)
-  Regional workshops, bringing together representatives from the same four regions

There were at least three meetings in each region and at the regional level: an initial workshop, followed by two specific workshops devoted to the choice of subjects and collaboration methods between stakeholders
